Summer Reading - 2017 Grade 12

In preparation for the Senior Capstone Project, the incoming seniors of Holbrook Middle High School are required to read a book associated with their approved Capstone topic. The reading can be a novel, memoir, historical non-fiction, biography, or autobiography.

In addition to reading their selected title, they will complete the included assignment. This assignment is meant to support students in their research by broadening their understanding and interest within their Senior Capstone Project. Prior to leaving junior year, students conducted research regarding what topics deeply interested them, including topics in career pathways, hobbies, or social issues.

The Senior Capstone encourages students to think analytically, logically, and creatively, and to integrate experience and knowledge to solve problems. The purpose is to give students a chance to explore a topic in which they have a great interest and offer the opportunity to apply their learning in a "real world" way. The Senior Capstone Project is a required course for all Holbrook seniors and helps determine students' mastery of 21st Century Learning Skills.

Students will receive an invitation to the Holbrook Capstone Google Classroom page prior to the end of the school year, where they can access this summer reading assignment. The 2017 Senior Summer Reading Assignment is to write a 2-page paper that includes the following:

- An explanation of approved Senior Capstone topic
- Title, author, and publication date
- A summary of your book
- An explanation of how the book is relevant to your approved Senior Capstone topic
- At least two quoted pieces of information that you could use in your own research paper (either scientific or anecdotal)
